Residual Bequest Language

Specific Bequest Language

Naming The Shipleys School as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

Contingent Bequest Language

The Shipleys School or its affiliates can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:
